

Appendix A: Petition to Enroll in the Honors Program

[Due by the end of the second semester of the Junior Year]

The Honors Program in Anthropology is open to selected majors who have maintained an overall grade point average of 3.65 and an average of 3.65 in the major. Honors Program candidates are expected to meet all the requirements for College Honors. Departmental Honors Program participants must complete a total of 40 points (typically ten 4-unit classes) of Anthropology course work (four units more than are required for majors not doing Honors), including a two semester capstone research/thesis writing sequence (ANTH-UA 950, *Honors Research I* and ANTH-UA 951, *Honors Research II*) plus at least one graduate-level course. All of these courses count toward the major.
