## PROVISIONAL PROGRAM OF STUDY

A statement of your provisional program of study for the PhD degree should be attached. It should be typed, double-spaced and not exceed five pages.

The program should be drawn up with the advice and approval of your advisors. It is **NOT** a proposal for writing a PhD dissertation. Rather, it is an outline of your interests and goals, and how you can best use your time to fulfill them in the PhD program. The statement should include:

1. A brief sketch of your PhD dissertation topic, how you chose it and how it fits into the larger anthropological picture.
2. A statement of why you have selected the three areas of interest and how they fit in with your proposed career and research interests in anthropology. **Biological Anthropology students should list the three pre-designated areas for the exams.**
3. A list of relevant courses you have already taken and propose to take. These should be justified with a statement of how they meet your needs and goals.
4. A statement of the time frame in which you expect to complete all requirements for the PhD degree.
