Academic Year 2017 – 2018

- **Admissions:** Applications to the Physics PhD and MS programs are due Monday, December 18, 2017, 5 PM EST.

- **Course Registration and Bursar Schedule:**

Fall 2017 – Last day to add/drop – Monday, September 18, 2017

Spring 2018 – Last day to add/drop – Sunday, February 4, 2018

- **Health Insurance:** NYU requires that all students registered in degree-granting programs maintain health insurance. Most students are enrolled automatically in the NYU-sponsored Student Health Insurance Plan as part of the course registration process. Students must complete the online enrollment/waiver process each academic year beginning in the fall to ensure that they are enrolled in the plan of their choice; supplement their current insurance with an NYU-sponsored plan, or waive the NYU-sponsored plans.

- **Graduate Student Teaching:** Teaching opportunities are available every fall and spring, and are administered through the Undergraduate and Graduate Offices. To be eligible for teaching, students must pass the Practicum in Teaching course (PHYS-GA-2090) offered every fall semester. Additionally, non-native English speaking students are required to take English placement exams and complete remedial coursework before applying to teach.

- **MacCracken Fellowship Reserve Program:** The MacCracken Fellowship Reserve Program (“MacCracken Reserve”) is a service provided to help students manage their MacCracken stipend support. It provides flexibility in how MacCracken fellowship stipends are distributed to support the pace and course of a student’s studies. A student’s participation in MacCracken Reserve is completely voluntary.
