Important note #1: **Get to 72 units!!!**

Important note #4: at least 36 units must be in NYU sociology (translation: **two of your electives need to be substantive courses in NYU sociology**)

Important note #5: **All courses taken outside NYU Sociology need to be approved by the Director of Graduate Studies!!**
