Recommended Breakdown of Minor

Advanced Languages (1 course/Required for non-native speakers-does not fulfill requirement for native speakers or students who get a grade of 720 or above in their language placement):

- Advanced Grammar and Composition (V95.0100)

Literature and Writing (4 or 5 courses):

- Critical Approaches: Reading, Writing and Textual Analysis (V95.0200)
Required course and pre-requisite of all advanced courses. Students who have placed out of V95.0200 Critical Approaches will complete the requirement by taking one elective course in literature.
- Creative Writing in Spanish (V95.0225)
Required for all students. Offered every semester.
- Advanced Poetry Workshop in Spanish (V95.0320)
Required for all students. Offered once a year.
- Advanced Fiction and Non-Fiction Workshop in Spanish (V95.0325)
Required for all students. Offered once a year

NOTE: All Students must have five (5) courses to complete the minor.
