**Breakdown of Minor**

Under this interdisciplinary minor, students combine studies in the literatures and cultures of Spain and/or Portugal with related courses offered in any other program or department throughout the University. Students in all disciplines have the opportunity to incorporate an interest in Spain and/or Portugal into their overall course of study. Individual programs of study, including study abroad opportunities such as NYU in Madrid, should be chosen in consultation with the Director of Undergraduate Studies. Language courses are prerequisites and do not count towards the Minor.
